### Output Analysis of the project

According to our recent survey, out of the 72 schools where the ICT project had been implemented, 40% of schools enhanced ICT facilities to the students. Out of 6000 students who were benefited through the ICT related 4 days program, 20% are securing their future in the ICT field.

Out of 491 students who had received free computer training, 55% students are securing their career in the ICT field, studying IT in national and international universities.
