

Report of Certification Program on 25th National Children's Day – 2071

After implementation of project "Vision of Nation: Technical Education from Childhood" / "देशको ध्यान बाल्यकालमै प्राविधिक ज्ञान" , a mutual project of Department of Education, Nepal and Conquer Nepal, as per the commitment of CN Nepal , CN Nepal provided free computer classes at Campion Kathmandu College, Gahanapokhari from Baishakh 2nd to Asar 25th 2071. Hence, to mark the 25th National Children's Day, CN Nepal organized certificate distribution program at Samundra Mana Vidhya Foundation, Gahanapokhari, Tangal at 29th Bhadra 2071. The program was conducted by students of Conquer Nepal who were provided free computer classes and has been engaged in various social programs organized by Conquer Nepal.

The program was formally addressed by Mr. Rabin Acharya, representative and member of CN Nepal, welcoming the program's chief guest, honorable guest, valuable guest, chairperson of the program, guests and all the participants and audiences of the program.



Then, to conduct the upcoming program, Ms. Sujata Kunwar, member student of CN Nepal was invited.

After that, the batch distribution program along with *Aashan Ghrahan* (Taking the sats) was taken into consideration by Ms. Goma Acharya and Ms. Sagun Shrestha, member student of CN Nepal. Moreover all the guests were honored by *Khada*.



After that, Ms. Sujata Kunwar, MC of the program called Honorable Guest: Mr. Auchut Pd. Sapkota to light *batti in panas* to have formal opening of the program.



After that, with the National Anthem of Nepal, the program was formally started. And for the National Anthem, Ms. Sujata Kunwar requested all the guests and participants of the program to rise up for the pride of Nation.



Then, in the process of conduction the program, MC of the program , Ms. Sujata Kunwar, explained the theme and statement of the program: " Let's Listen to the Children: Stop Child Abuse". She also described that , we CN Nepal is not only having certificate distribution program but also having a program to mark and have small effort against Child Abuse. She explained meanwhile when we are here celebrating the program, thousand's of children are being victimized and are being abused.



Then, Ms. Sujata Kunwar, invited Ms. Sushma Mall, member student of CN Nepal for the Welcome Speech.



After that, MC of the program, explaining the importance and value of culture in our life, society and whole Nation, invited Ms. Anju Tamang, Ms. Sushma Malla, Mr. Rabin Acharya and Mr. Saroj Pakhrin, member students of CN Nepal for a cultural dance.

The group dance was performed on typical Nepali Tamang Selo which was appreciated by all the participants of the program.



Then, the guest of program Mr. Milan Rai, was called for his views about the project.

Mr. Milan Rai thanking the organizer and once more welcoming the other guest explained how the project has been taken into action. He explained that only theoretical education is not sufficient for career development. We need practical technological knowledge too. He also added that the students, who are not present here or had not been benefited by free computer classes and other facilities of CN Nepal, one day they will realize what CN Nepal had taught in 4 days IT related boot camp was really essential if they wanted to develop their career.

Moreover, he added that due to some reason he could not continue in working in CN Nepal and for this he feels sorry too. At last wishing best of luck to all the students and CN Nepal for better achievement, Mr. Milan Rai concluded his words.



After that to mark the 25th National Children's Day, and to reflect the present scenario of the street children, Ms. Goma Acharya, member student of CN Nepal, recited a poem, "*Khate*" / "Street Children". The poem was quite heart torching and the poem was beautifully written to express how the life of street children and what dream do the street children have. The poem was so much appreciated by guest and other audiences too.



After that, Ms. Sujata Kunwar, MC of the program focused that CN Nepal is established only for development, development of students, children, CN Nepal tries to explore the new talents.

For the reason, Mr. Bhuwan Tamang, member student of CN Nepal, was called upon the stage for a solo song performance. The song was titled "*Bahguwa*". The guitar performance along with his confident singing made everyone feel the song from heart and the performances was appreciated with round of blows.



Then to make the program more exciting and entertaining, Ms. Saraswoti Tamang was called upon the stage for a dance. The dance was well choreographed in modern Dancing Style which was again the topic of appreciation for all.

Then in course of further conduction of the program the MC of the program, Mr. Rabin Acharya, announced for a drama.

The drama was titled "Child Abuse"/ "*Bal Shram*" and Ms. Anju Tamang, member student of CN Nepal and narrator of the drama with the statement that no higher authority is taking child abuse cases in more sensitive way. Explaining the present condition of the children specially orphans described the scenario of the drama.

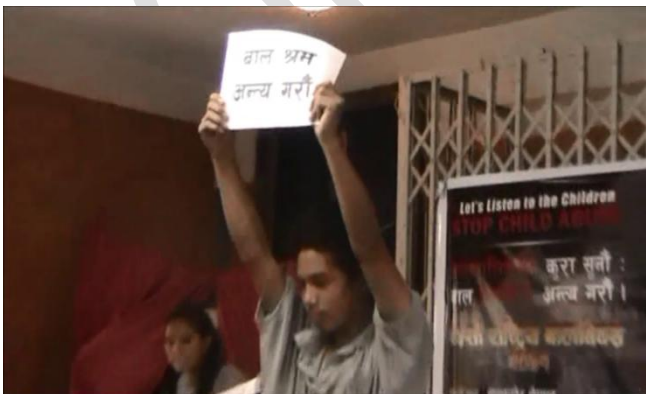
The drama was based on Child Abuse. The main role of the drama, Prakash was a child worker at Sundar's Hotel where he was supposed to do lots of works. He was not given any opportunity for study, he even was not given enough food and salary too. The drama was a dream of Prakash and was successfully choreographed and presented by the member students of CN Nepal.

At he hotel, the Prakash was being victimized and was abused. In the course of drama, a character Aasha and Prakash accidently meet at the road, whety they shared each other problems. Aasha was also a child victim and was worker at a Lady Teacher's House.

Meanwhile a dance was performed in the song " Mero Aakha ma" to make the drama more realistic. The dance ultimately reflects that the may children are begging for their rights but no one else is listening them, hearing them or understand them.

At the end of drama, the Prakash and other were rescued but only in dream. The drama ended with the message that " Let's Listen to the Children: Stop Child Abuse".

The drama was so effective and heart touching that, the performance was given standing ovation from all.



With above realistic statement, Ms. Ashwason Sigdel, executive member of CN Nepal was invited for appealing vote of thanks to all.



In his speech, he explained what CN Nepal has been doing and what will CN Nepal do in future. With the vote of thanks to all: chief guest, honorable guest, valuable guest, guest, students, teacher, project representatives and other called the program's honorable guest, Mr. Auchut Pd. Sapkota and Chief Guest, Mr. Nilambar Badal for the distribution of certificate of achievement for having free computer classes. In the certificates, even performance grading was given. Moreover the certificate was verified by DOE, Nepal.



In course of providing free computer classes, CN Nepal conducted various ECAs like Badminton competition, Table Tennis Competition, Debate Competition, Quiz competition and other. And for the certificate distribution of various competitions to the winners, Mr. Shreejan Sapkota, valuable guest of the program was called upon the stage.



After the certificate distribution program, Mr. Nilambar Badal, chief guest of the program was called for the speech.

In the speech, Mr. Nilambar Badal thanking the organizer CN Nepal and welcoming all, he stated that technical education is very much important and the education must be provided for school life and also suggested students to be connected with technical education.

After that, he said that the dream of the abused children now shall not remain the dream any more as everybody is now more concentrated and working on it. But also we all have to support. Moreover, he also explained about the *Bishwo Maha Sandhi* related to child rights of 1992.

Not only this, he also clarify that children are being abused unknowingly too. And for that we should know what is child right and what is written in UN convention of Child Rights of 1992.

At last, appreciation the whole performance of the students and with the commitment of providing 10 days Drama Training Course for 5 interested students, he concluded his speech saying " *Aafno Utsaha kahile namarnuhos*" / "Never kill your enthusiasm".



Thanking the CN Nepal, he took his initiation.

In his speech, he explained how he struggle in his life and achieved success. Beside the struggle, how he managed the developmental works like library set up, establish various clubs, schools building, construction of roadways, temples and many more. He also stated that with only his struggle, how he became Chairman of Ward and Chairperson of Community Police, Tudaldevi. As a whole, he wants to say that if we can take our responsibilities as a good and honest citizen, whether you are in power or not, it doesn't matter, no body can stop our works and mission. Moreover, he also stated that for any developmental works, we need only support, joint co-operation and team work. Hence with his words he inspired students for change.

At last, again appreciating all the performances and acts, he concluded his speech.



After that, at last, for ending of the program, the chairperson of CN Nepal and program's chairperson, Mr. Kishor Pd. Poudel was called upon stage.

Wishing Namaskar and welcoming and thanking chief guest, honorable guest, valuable guest, guests, students, teacher, project representatives and all, he begin his speech.

In his speech, he defined what exactly Conquer Nepal is. He said that CN Nepal is just a mediator, a mediator for change as CN Nepal is trying to change the society into a developed society.
