### A Report on Missio Dei Social Mission Trip with Nepal

23 - 30 January 2018

**Life Line Non Profit Corporation**, one of the leading and pioneer non stock corporations of South Korea is independent organization working for the persons with disabilities. Many remarkable projects, programs and activities have been successfully completed in S. Korea.

On behalf of **Missio Dei**, the team comprising of seven members made Social Mission Trip with Nepal from **23rd January to 30th January 2018** with the intention to support Nepalese Civil Society Organization working/trying to work in the field of Persons with Disabilities and to enhance strong relationship with Nepal and enhance brotherhood among all Nepalese.

The team includes: 유흥주 (Yoo Heung-ju), 박승유 (Seung Yu Park), 황종순 (Hwang Jong Soon), 박기주 (Park Ki Joo), 남구 (Nam-gu), 정원희 (Jung WonHee) and 홍준표 (Hong Joon-pyo).

On the sincere notification, Conquer Nepal, organization in Special Consultative Status with UN ECOSOC, Kathmandu, Nepal made all the logistics and transportation arrangement during the trip.

**23 rd January 2018 - 6:30 PM - Tuesday** A small team of Conquer Nepal including Mr. Kishor Prasad Poudel - President/C.E.O, Mr. Yuhanna Kapri - F. Member and Mr. Jeevan Neupane - F. Member of Conquer Nepal, welcomed Missio Dei Team at Tribhuvan International Airport, Kathmandu, Nepal.

The lodging arrangement was made in Hotel Hardik, Bagbazar, Kathmandu, Nepal, only one disable friendly boutique Hotel of Kathmandu. For the 7 guest, 4 Disable Friendly Double Rooms were allocated in advance.



## 24th January 2018 - Wednesday

In coordination with Bijeta Church, Kathmandu, Nepal, a 2 days motivational and psycho social counseling seminar for the motivation of persons with disabilities was conducted by Conquer Nepal. The seminar consists of 2 sessions each of 2 hours and followed by Hi-Tea and Lunch. For the seminar, Korean Missio Dei Team Member Ps. 유흥주 (Yoo Heung-ju) was a key speaker and presenter which were facilitated in English by 박승유 (Seung Yu Park) and in Nepali by Mr. Yuhanna Kapri. There were almost 120 participants who include: 7 people were differently Abled (disable), 65 females, 15 children and 33 males. And there were 7 volunteers for the assist of people with disabilities. The portable disable friendly toilet has been managed by Conquer Nepal for persons with disabilities and every disabled participant were facilitated by Travel Expenses too.



After the end of first day motivational seminar, the Missio Dei Team was given a short city tour Mandikhatar to Balaju. After the brief overview of the program at Hotel Hardik followed by Korean Foods the first day program has been completed.

### 25th January 2018 - Thursday

The 2nd day started with the remaining session of 2 days motivational and psycho social counseling seminar for persons with disabilities at same venue of 24th Jan. 2018. The seminar was followed by Lunch and participants included persons with disabilities, children, parents and so. There were almost 100 participants and 7 volunteers for assist. 홍준표 (Hong Joon-pyo) and her colleague were key speaker and presenter which were facilitated in English by 박승유 (Seung Yu Park) and in Nepali by Mr. Yuhanna Kapri.



After the seminar, arrangements were made to have visit of World Heritage Site by UNESCO - Shyambhunath (Buddhist Temple). Along with the Missio Dei Team and Conquer Nepal Team the Shyambhunath tour has been taken into consideration.





**26th January 2018 - Friday**

To have overview how Nepalese Civil Society Organization is working in the field of Disabilities, a 2 hours morning field visit to Nepal Disable Association: Khagendra New Life Center has been organized. The organization presented their presentation on their present and future works, projects and activities.



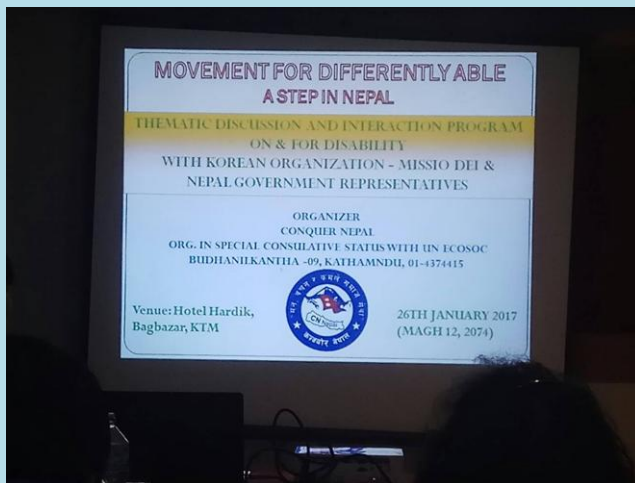
After the organization visit, a motivational seminar for students has been organized by Gyan Chakshu English High School, Bhetghat Chowk, Budhanilkantha -7, Kathmandu in coordination with Conquer Nepal. On behalf of Missio Dei Team, 유흥주 (Yoo Heung-ju), 박승유 (Seung Yu Park), and 박기주 (Park Ki Joo) addressed the seminar. There were almost presence of 120 school students, parents and teachers. The seminar strongly came up with vision that motivated students, parents and even school.

The seminar was followed by Nepalese Cultural Program performed by school students.



After the program, at evening Conquer Nepal arranged meeting of Missio Dei Team with Deputy Mayor of Kathmandu Metropolitan City, Mrs. Hariprava Khadgi Shrestha followed by Dinner Program at Hotel Hardik and all the logistics arrangement were made by Hotel Management.

The meeting was titled "Thematic Discussion and Interaction program on & for Disability" and there were 18 participants in the meeting including representative from Tribhuvan University, National Investigation Department, Nepal Tarun Dal - Congress Youth Wings and Ktm Paragliding and local politicians of Nepal.



The meeting highlighted on the present condition of persons with Disabilities in Nepal. In the meeting Deputy Mayor - KMC, Mrs. Hariprava Khadgi Shrestha highlighted her future plans to develop Kathmandu and make disable friendly environment. She also highlighted and insisted Missio Dei Team to work in Nepal. Finally she committed to provide any sorts of support the works of Missio Dei if the team works with Nepal and Nepalese CSO's like Conquer Nepal.

The meeting came up with some specific recommendations upon special children education, infrastructure development, education, health, sports policies and plans regarding persons with disabilities.





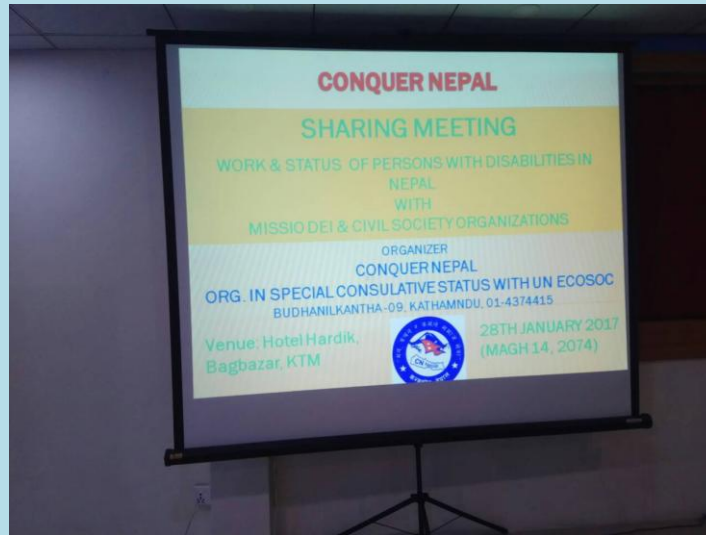
**27th January 2018 - Saturday**

In this day, Missio Dei team participated in regular weekly pray of Bijeta Church, Kathmandu. Just after the prayer, the Missio Dei Team distributed gifts to children, parents and participants. The forum enabled NGO's working in Nepal in the field of Disabilities to explore their present works, activities and future planning and projects.



In the afternoon, the Missio Dei visited one of the church at Jwaulakhel, Lalitpur regarding works and activities related to persons with disabilities.

But unfortunately, the visit of Conquer Nepal was cancelled due to some health issues.

**29th January 2018 - Monday**

In the morning of day, it was supposed to have meeting with State Education Minister of Nepal with Missio Dei Team, but due to health issues, the meeting was cancelled.

The afternoon of the day was very different of other days. Missio Dei Team visited a park of Thamel - Dreams of Garden.



Moreover, the team visited streets of Thamel in their wheelchairs and had some souvenir of Nepal and had some shopping too. We all had lunch in Korean Restaurant at Thamel.



As it was the last night for Missio Dei Team, a small farewell program was organized by Conquer Nepal. A small Choir was invited for entertainment. The event came up with specific commitment from Missio Dei Team and Conquer Nepal.



Missio Dei Team committed to support Conquer Nepal in the works related to Disabilities. Moreover, they committed to establish brotherhood relation with Nepal, Nepalese and Bijeta Church. Likewise, Conquer Nepal also committed to work in the field of Disabilities and set examples to Nepal and Nepalese Civil Society Organization.
